Visiting Hours

- In order for our staff to provide the highest quality care, **visiting hours are from 10am to 8pm**
- Guests outside of these hours are permitted if they are respectful of the needs of our patients to have quiet time to rest
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Hospice House staff may ask guests to leave if they are disruptive to patients and other visitors

Smoking Policy

- For the health and safety of our patients, visitors, and staff, the Burnett Calvert Hospice House is a smoke-free facility. **Tobacco products and electronic cigarettes are prohibited on Hospice House property.**

Pet Policy

- Pets are not permitted inside the Burnett Calvert Hospice House
- Pet therapy dogs come to the Hospice House each week and will be happy to visit with your loved one

Kitchen Safety

- Burnett Calvert Hospice House employees and volunteers are specially trained in food safety and infection control regulations
- In keeping with county Health Department regulations, **family members and visitors are not permitted to store or prepare food in the Hospice House kitchen**
- Visitors are welcome to bring outside food and non-alcoholic drinks to share with your loved one. Please ask a Hospice House staff member to store or prepare it if needed.

To Make a Donation

- Ask for a list of frequently needed items such as sheets, towels, and kitchen supplies
- Envelopes are available for monetary donations in the Hospice House foyer
- Please speak with your nurse or social worker prior to donating any medical or personal care items to the Hospice House, due to limitations on what we are able to accept
- Hospice House staff are not permitted to accept monetary or other gifts. If you would like to provide any kind of gift to Hospice House staff, please speak with the Director of Clinical Operations first.

What to Bring

- Current, prescribed medications in their original containers
- Toiletries, such as toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, lotion
- Dentures and eyeglasses, if needed
- Loose, comfortable clothing or gowns, non-skid socks or slippers
- Photos and cards to place on memory board or on top of dresser
- Favorite foods or snacks to be kept in personal bin in pantry

What NOT to Bring

- OTC or other medications unless instructed by nurse
- Any medications in pill boxes or outside of their original containers
- Alcohol, unless prescribed by the physician and directed by the nurse
- Pictures to hang on wall (no nails or tacks permitted in wall)
- Tobacco products or electronic cigarettes
- Furniture
